Applying for Certification

Individual Application considered by TRA Certification International is:

- Evaluated based on the individual's demonstration of Competencies:
 - Effective for QMS or EMS Auditing
 - Demonstrating a combination of:
 - education
 - work experience
 - training and
 - audit experience



□ Education:

For all levels of certification an applicant is required to have completed a minimum of secondary education.

☐ Work Experience:

- > 5 years of general, relevant work experience is required for all levels unless the applicant holds a degree or near degree. In this case, the experience requirement is lowered to 4 years.
- Relevant work experience is considered to be technical, managerial or professional positions that require use of judgment, problem solving, and communication with management, employees, customers and stakeholders.

☐ Work Experience Quality or Environmental:

- ➤ Quality or environmental work experience is also required, where quality or environmental and quality or environmental issues formed the major part of the job. (Internal Auditor levels = 1 year experience; All other levels = 2 yrs experience).
- ➤ Such experience must have provided the applicant with the practical knowledge necessary to audit quality or environmental management systems effectively and may be included as part of the 4 or 5 year general work experience.

□ Auditor Training:

- > Internal Auditor level:
 - ✓ Applicant must complete an acceptable <u>foundation training</u> or
 - ✓ Training Requirement for <u>any other grade</u>.

> All other levels-

- ✓ Applicant must successfully complete Accepted
 - QMS ore EMS Auditor/Lead Auditor Training.
 - ♣ Training or program must be at least 40 hours duration and may include on-site training, self learning, distance learning, and/or e-learning.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING FOR CERTIFICATION

□Auditing Experience:

- > Provisional Auditor Level,
 - ✓ No Requirement for Auditing Experience.

> Internal Auditor level,

- ✓ Applicant must have
 - Completed 5 internal or second party audits
 - each at least 3 hours in duration and
 - include ALL elements of Audit Cycle;
 - audit planning,
 - document review,
 - auditing, interviewing,
 - audit reporting

> Auditor level

- ✓ Applicant must have
 - Completed at least 4 complete audits.
 - Auditing activity must include
 - document review
 - preparation
 - performance onsite
 - audit reporting
 - duration must not be less than 20 days with 16 days onsite

> Lead Auditor level,

- ✓ Applicant must have
 - Completed 4 audits (required for Auditor level)
 - Plus 3 acceptable audits as the leader
 - ✓ Including at least one other auditor.
 - ✓ Duration of 3 LEAD audits; not less than 15 days with 12 days on site
 - Recommended Audits required to be (Auditor and Lead Auditor levels)
 - Completed under direction & guidance of Certified Team Auditor(CTA)
 - ✓ Team leader however it is acknowledged, may be difficult &costly to arrange: TRACI will accept
 - Minimum of 1 audit under these conditions and
 - May require the team leader from that 1 audit to attest to competence, of applicant, to audit as a team member or team leader.
